In the evaluation of tenders and to achieve the most advantageous offer will be checked:

- similar exercise control with the assignment under occupation work of the candidate
- technical bid evaluation
- evaluation of the financial offer

The tender is posted in Greek and English in order to open the contract award to competition.

Indicative budget: 18.000 euros, VAT included.

The purpose of the tender is to occupy an experienced external expert to take over the (3) following responsibilities:

1) The tenderer will be responsible for the monitoring of the Community's Thematic Working Group (TWG) entitled as TWG1- "Resource Efficiency" tackling issues linked to the aspect of Production and Consumption of the circular economy, involving so far the following modular projects (MPs) of the Green Growth Community: PEFMED, CAMARG, MED GREENHOUSES, MADRE and ESMARTCITY. The list of the involved Modulars will be confirmed. The contractor will be working closely with the MPs and Dynamic Vision, responsible partner of TWG1, in order to conclude in the possible intervention of the projects to the circular economy's policies. Communication will



take place through online and face-to-face meetings and should be available to travel when needed.

- 2) The tenderer will be also in contact with the experts responsible for the other TWGs of the Community, in order to collect their conclusions in the framework of their legal interventions. The tenderer is expected to assist the community at all stages in order to design and apply the best methodology related to the TWGs.
- 3) The final report will be the "Legal recommendation" report, a synthesis of the capitalization results of the Green Growth Thematic Working Groups, linking the MPs' outcomes to the aspects contributing to the implementation of the Circular Economy Package.

The legal barriers and possibilities for interventions/exchanges among the MS will be explored, identified and determined. The results will be gathered and reported in a way to be further exploited addressing relevant policy makers constituting a product boosting the capitalization activity of the Green Growth community as a whole.

## **Project summary**

MED-Interreg project. Duration 36 months.

Priority Axis 1: Promoting Mediterranean innovation capacities to develop smart and sustainable growth.

PI 1.b. Investment Priority 1.1. To increase transnational activity of innovative clusters and networks of key sectors of the MED area.

Thematic area. Green Growth.

SYNGGI aims to support the modular approved projects under the objective Green Growth of the priority Axis 1. Innovation of the Interreg MED Programme. The activities will support the sub-objective 1.1 and especially the Green Growth sub-priority, in order to serve the targets and strategies of the Managing Authorities for the MED Area. The project has been designed as an agile tool that will unify project results, support MED stakeholders and create a fruitful and collaborative environment for all implicated bodies.

Additionally, the project will fully comply with the Interreg-MED strategy according to which the Horizontal projects will act as a bridge between the Modular projects, the Governance project-"platform"- of Axis 4 and the EU policy makers. The consortium members are powerful actors; networks or clusters of private and public character and have been chosen so that they can create a vast network of key groups including SMEs, academics, research institutes and governing authorities (Quadruple helix representatives).



SYNGGI has been structured to support communication, capitalization activities and at the same time it aims beyond MED territories, across all EU countries, as deemed fit by the Programme Authorities. That way the project is a valuable adjustable partner for the Interreg Programme, ready to answer to its needs and offer innovative solutions that will produce unified results and solid proposals for environmental policies.

# Thematic Working Groups of the Green Growth Community

In the framework of the SYNGGI Capitalization Work Package, the Interreg MED Green Growth Community will analyse and transfer the results delivered by the Modular Projects (MPs) of the community to capitalize the main outcomes to reach EU stakeholders and create policy recommendations for EU policy-makers.

Thematic Working Groups (TWGs) are created in order to facilitate systematic technical cooperation, synergies and joint work among the modulars in view of capitalization and policy outputs. The TWGs will also support the horizontal project to gather in a homogenous way the Modular Projects' policy inputs.

Taking into account the strong relevance of our community thematic for the circular economy pillar, as well as the dynamism of this theme at EU level and the vivid legal framework that needs constant revision and input, the themes of the TWGs were related to the EU Circular Economy (CE) Action Plan and the indicator framework, developed by the EC and released on 01/18, aiming at measuring progress of CE's various dimensions at all stages of the lifecycle of resources, products and services.

Among with external expert, the TWGs will be composed by partners of the Modular Projects of the MED Green Growth community and SYNGGI Associated Partners and will be moderated by a SYNGGI partner having the most relevant experience for the respective theme. It is recommended that each modular project designates at least two representatives from the partnership to join one or more TWG consisting by a technical coordinator with an extensive overview on the technical work deployed in the respective project and a policy coordinator in charge of the capitalization / policy inputs working package(s) of the project.

Communication by email and participation in on-line meetings, webinars and face-to-face meetings are expected to take place until June 2019.

Aligned with the EU top priorities and CE indicators, the TWGs are the following:

TWG 1: Resource Efficiency

TWG 2: Smart and Green Public Services

TWG 3: Waste prevention & Management

TWG 4: Competitiveness and Innovation

### **Procurement process**

This procurement is an open call for tender where all suitable companies are invited to submit offers. All members of the tender team are expected to have relevant qualifications



and proven experience. Before submitting we strongly advise you visit the Interreg MED website and study carefully the content and demands of the Programme.

## Content of tender and award criteria

The tender shall be structured like this:

- 1. Competence/experience. Summary of experience with similar work. This section shall consist of brief descriptions of the most relevant experiences the proposed entity has worked with. The responsibilities and the year/period of the task shall be included. Experience in management and capitalization of European projects is essential. Relevance with resource efficiency policies will be an asset.
- 2. Quality of proposal. The proposal must be well structured, accurate and comprehensive.
- 2.1 Methodology. Description of the applicant's approach to delivering the requested services and specific methodology that will be applied in this assignment. It should include a short description of the approach on how to monitor the "resource efficiency" TWG, the communication with the other TWGs of the project and the methodology of the development of the legal recommendations report.
- 2.2 Understanding of the assignment. Brief description of the legal recommendations' Components.
- 3. Price offer
- 4. Availability within the period: **24 January 2019- 31 October 2019**. This part should indicate the availability of the team leader and any collaborating experts within the proposed time period.
- 5. Any other supporting documentation, if necessary.
- 6. Award criteria (scores). Each tender will be assessed as described below. The contract will be awarded to the offer with the overall highest score:
